### Oshkosh Defense Tactical Protector Vehicle

Oshkosh Defense has designed a purpose-built vehicle to meet the tough challenges faced by today’s tactical officers. The Oshkosh Tactical Protector Vehicle (TPV) – a high-mobility protected tactical vehicle – offers a high-speed, highly maneuverable mobile shield that can be specifically configured to serve a variety of tactical situations. The vehicle’s profile is subtle yet commanding. Its engineering provides the optimal balance of mobility, protection and payload to meet the most rigorous law-enforcement demands over a wide range of missions. Officers can get in, get around and gain control of any situation.

- **The Value:** Law enforcement officers need swift and safe access to high-risk situations and close-quarter deployments to protect people and property. The Oshkosh TPV offers the perfect balance of armored protection, tactical equipment and size. The vehicle allows tactical officers to confidently handle potentially dangerous situations at a price comparable to other armored vehicles used for citizen and officer protection.
- **The Armor:** The versatile TPV features a customizable armor system to adapt to the demands of a range of missions. The modular armor system is designed to meet or exceed requirements posed by today’s threats. The vehicle-protection ratings range from NIJ Level I to Level IV, with the capability of stopping a 7.62 ball through .50 cal. AP rounds. The under-body armor and suspended-seat systems provide safety and security for officers and passengers.
- **The High Mobility:** To help tactical officers overcome mobility and access challenges in high-risk situations, the TPV’s compact size and maneuverability is well-suited to tight urban settings, as well as expansive, rugged or wooded rural environments. The vehicle offers a 6.4L V8 diesel, 325-hp engine and selectable 4-wheel drive with a maximum speed of 75 mph.

- **The Options:** The vehicle can be customized to accommodate up to eight officers and can be configured to meet virtually any law enforcement agency's tactical needs with exterior and interior modifications. The transport variant has a payload capacity of 3,650 pounds and the utility variant has a payload capacity of 4,650 pounds. Exterior options include rear step/grab handles and side boards/hand rails to enable rapid deployment. Additional options include a wide array of exterior lighting, FLIR, ladders, second-story entrance ramps and winches. Interior seating and storage elements also can be specified to meet user requirements.
